## **Making Music In Our Community**

### **Veterans Day Celebration:**

The 8<sup>th</sup> grade Chamber Orchestra, 8<sup>th</sup> grade Band and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Choir will be performing at the Veterans Day breakfast and program at 7:45 am on November 10<sup>th</sup>.

### **Austin Symphony Orchestra:**

Our community's symphony orchestra is in its 61st season and is celebrating with the theme of "With Strings Attached". This talented group of musicians, whose age and expertise spans 7 decades, will be providing entertainment in 4 concerts:

- *Swinging at the Symphony* featuring Austin Big Band and Brian Koser on alto saxophone. The main performance will be on October 29 and again on October 30 for many area school children.
- *A Trans-Siberian Christmas* is the theme on December 10 and will feature the Austin Symphony Chorus and the Galactic Cowboy Orchestra.
- *Beethoven and Bruch* featuring Emma Andersen on violin, will be February 25 at the Paramount Theater.
- *Sarah Chang!!*, featuring Sarah Chang on violin, will be performing the Bernstein Suite for Violin and Orchestra on May 6<sup>th</sup>. A fundraiser at the Austin Country Club will follow.

All concerts start at 2 pm and with the exception of *Beethoven and Bruch*, the location of the performances are in Knowlton Auditorium at Austin High School.

### **The Northwestern Singers:**

The Northwestern Singers will present their annual benefit concert, "Why We Sing" on Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 pm at St Olaf Church. Guest choirs will include the Austinaires, 8<sup>th</sup> grade choir, IJ Holton 5<sup>th</sup> grade choir and choirs from Pacelli.

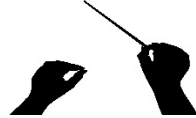


### **Tuba Christmas**

As this school year opens, the students look forward to many successful rehearsals, concerts, festivals, and contests. The resources needed to maintain the music programs is primarily provided by the school district, including staff salaries and benefits, facility space, supply budgets, equipment budgets, and much more. The MBA is designed to provide additional resources to the music programs, be they for exciting new opportunities, upgrades to existing opportunities, or to meet ongoing needs.

In recent years, the MBA has provided scholarships for students attending summer music camps, purchased numerous instruments, provided transportation to events both within and outside of Austin, and contributed towards the purchase of new chairs for the stage in Knowlton Auditorium. We accomplish this through support from fundraising and memberships.

Throughout the year, memberships in the MBA may be purchased. The price of membership starts at \$1 and as your contribution increases, you may receive a season ticket (single, couple, or family) to music performances at Austin High School. This is an exceptional value and proceeds go to fund music programs across the Austin Public Schools.
